Have your students cut out all of the picture cards on page two. For each card, students should stick it on the correct box on the Air Pollution Sorting Game worksheet, depending on whether they think that card shows a cause of, effect of, or solution to air pollution.

Once the students are finished, reveal the correct answers (see below) and answer any questions that came up during the activity.

Key word:

Cause

Something that creates air pollution. The reason why there is pollution in the air.

Answers: cars, aeroplanes, fires, factories

Key word:

Effect

Something that happens because pollution has been released into the air.

Answers: asthma, headaches, plants struggle to grow, , global warming

Key word:

Solution

Something that we can do to reduce air pollution and improve air quality.

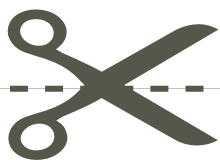
Answers: cycling, walking, planting trees, raising awareness

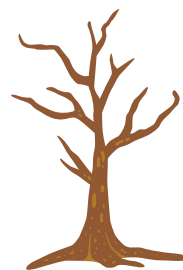
